ATTEND: The Ogden FamilySearch Library offers training to new Family History Consultants the first Thursday of every month at 6:00 p.m. Call **801-626-1132** to register for the class. (The class is 1 ½ hours)

EXPLORE: Go to the Ogden Family Search Library's website for a host of information to assist with your training. One notable feature is the list of classes taught at the Library for anyone who wishes to register. You may also register to receive an e-mail copy of the Library's monthly newsletter. PARTICIPATE: In the annual Family History Conference hosted by the Library the second Saturday of September. It is free, and very informative.

VOLUNTEER: Volunteering at the Ogden FSL is an excellent way to gain the skills you'll need to become a confident F H Consultant. All staff members receive regular training to provide a valuable service to patrons. (P. 12 To Turn the Hearts) The handbook strongly recommends that consultants serve at the local FH library.

INVOLVE: Primary – Encourage your Primary President to register for next year's Family History Summer Camp. Over fifty groups and over 700 youth attended the 2013 Camp.
Young Men and Women – Have your YW and YM frequent the Family Search Library for mutual. To learn indexing, research, Family Tree, find names for the Temple, or work on a Merit Badge.
Relief Society and Priesthood Groups – You are welcome to schedule Library computer rooms for any kind of family history lessons you want. There are five rooms with fifteen + computers each. Our staff will be willing to teach any number of subjects that are pre-scheduled.
